Introduction to Bike Mechanics Training Program:

Venture North Bike & Coffee Shop serves the growing biking community in North Minneapolis. Part of our mission is to provide educational and employment opportunities for local youth. All About Bikes (AAB) is a hands-on mechanic training course intended to serve as the equivalent to one season of employment in a professional bike shop. In AAB we'll discuss bicycle history, perform repairs and assessments, learn best practices for customer service, and equip students with an applicable and adaptable skill set.

Individuals who are interested also have the ability to receive training working at the coffee bar learning retail and barista skills.

Applicant Requirements:

All About Bikes is open to individuals ages 15 - 23. *No bike experience needed!* Applicants should show a commitment to providing excellent customer service, have an interest in alternative transportation, possess a strong work ethic (punctuality, appearance, follow-through), and desire to learn in a hands-on environment. Applicants also need some writing ability and a willingness to take short proficiency exams.

***Interviews will be scheduled from February 24th to the 28th.** * *By submitting your application, you are committing to attending the full program session, from March 9th through April 2nd.* Interns work 8 hours per week. Please contact Venture North to discuss specific program hours.
